A Global Burden of Disease (GBD) population based study estimated the annual mortality rate due to road traffic accidents as 20.9/1,00,000 population across Asia in 2002.

Pelvis and Acetabular fractures are considered a major cause of disability and mortality and often result in long recovery periods. As such there is a need for structured pre-hospital, in-hospital and post-operative healthcare delivery systems monitored by trained and experienced Pelvi-Acetabular trauma surgeons.

## About Jodhpur

**Jodhpur** is the second largest city in the Indian state of Rajasthan. After its population crossed a million, it has been declared as the second 'Metropolitan City' of Rajasthan. It was formerly the seat of a princely state of the same name, the capital of the kingdom known as Marwar. Jodhpur is a popular tourist destination, featuring many palaces, forts and temples, set in the stark landscape of the Thar.

The city is known as the "Sun City" for the bright, sunny weather it enjoys all the year round. It is also referred to as the "Blue City" due to the vivid blue-painted houses around the Mehrangarh Fort. The old city circles the fort and is bounded by a wall with several gates. Jodhpur's attractions include Mehrangarh Fort, Palace, Jaswant Thada, Ghanta Ghar (Clock Tower) and Flying Fox [Mehrangarh Fort]. Tourists can make excursions to Mandore, Kaylana Lake and Garden, Balsamand Lake, Sardar Samand Lake and Palace, Masooria Hills, Veer Durgadas Smarak (monument, park and museum), Bhim Bhirak Cave.
