- 1. 1.All the abstracts submitted must be written in **English**.
- 2. The topic should be relevant to Parasitology.
- 3. Abstract should not be longer than 250 words and must be written under following headings: Background, Objective, Methodology, Results and Conclusion.
- 4. For Case reports: Introduction, Case Management and Conclusion
- 5. Do not include Pictures, Tables and Charts within the abstract.
- 6. All abstracts submitted for Oral/Poster presentation will first be reviewed before acceptance.
- 7. The abstracts for Oral/Poster presentation must be sent as a soft copy (Word/PDF) to the Email ID: tropacon2023@gmail.com
- 8. For Award category Abstract submission kindly go through the guidelines as per the brochure and mail the abstract to khuranasumeeta@gmail.com
- 9. Confirmation regarding acceptance for Oral/Poster presentation will be communicated via Email.
- 10. Posters must be printed on **3' X 4'** size paper only in **Portrait layout**. Any other size posters will not be allowed.
- 11. Oral presentation must be prepared on a MS PowerPoint presentation format containing not more than 15 slides.
- 12. Registration is mandatory for abstract submission.
- 13. Last Date for Abstract Submission is 30th September 2023.

Guidelines for Quiz participation:

- 1. Each team will have Two UG (MBBS) candidates for UG QUIZ, and PG and/or SR in any combinations for RESIDENT QUIZ.
- 2. Team members should be from the same Institution/College.
