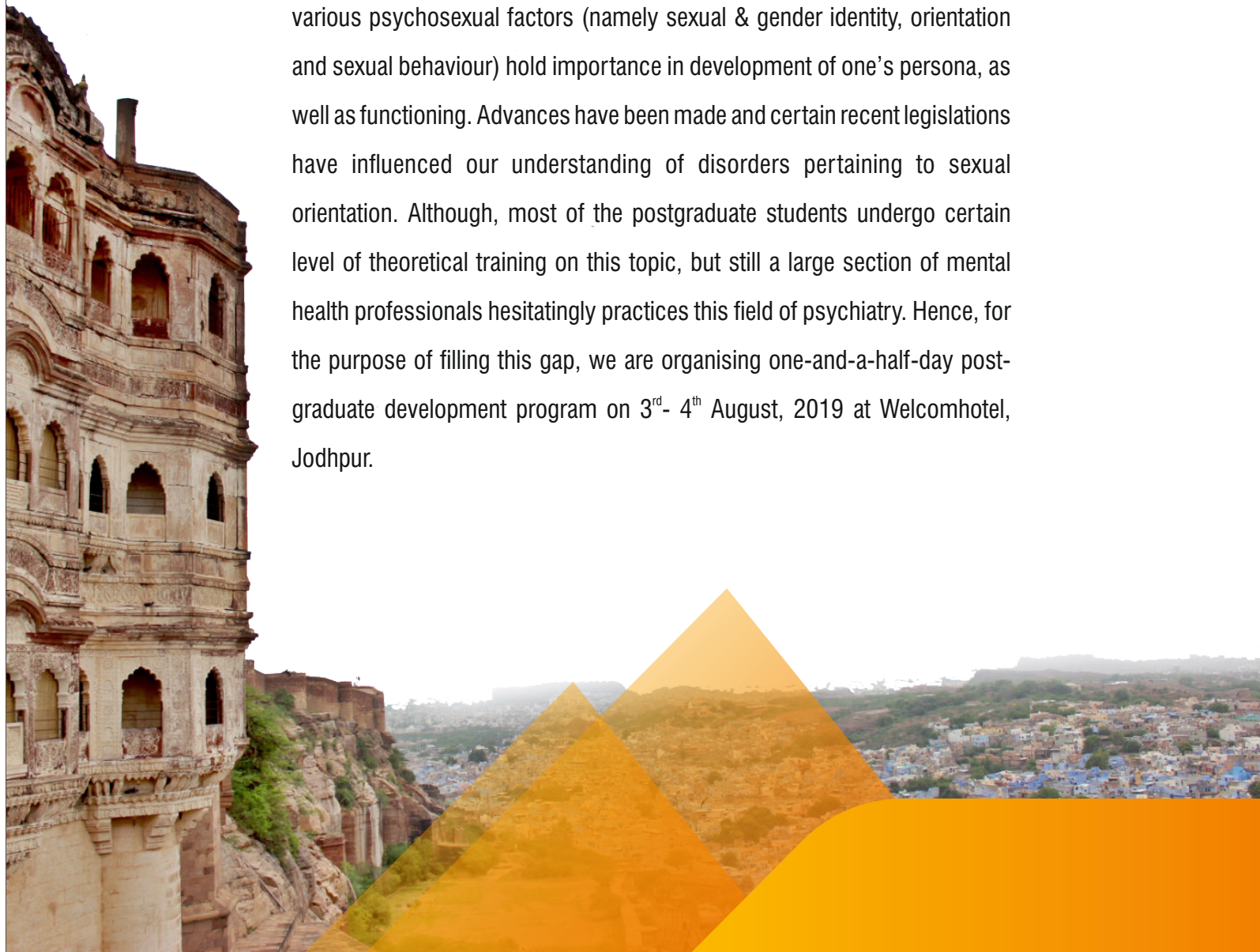

Invitation

We are happy to announce the 19th Postgraduate Development Program under the aegis of Indian Psychiatric Society-North Zone which is being organized by the Department of Psychiatry, AIIMS Jodhpur on 3rd - 4th August 2019. The theme is "Psychosexual disorders" & it will be a one and a half day program for this year's PGDP .

To introduce the topic, "Sexuality" as a subject has intrigued the medical practitioners since eternity. Sigmund Freud's conceptualisation of sexuality and various behaviours added an altogether different connotation. The various psychosexual factors (namely sexual & gender identity, orientation and sexual behaviour) hold importance in development of one's persona, as well as functioning. Advances have been made and certain recent legislations have influenced our understanding of disorders pertaining to sexual orientation. Jodhpur is a city in the Thar Desert of the northwest Indian state of Rajasthan. Its 15th-century Mehrangarh Fort is a former palace that's now a museum, displaying weapons, paintings and elaborate royal palanquins (sedan chairs). Set on a rocky outcrop, the fort overlooks the walled city, where many buildings are painted the city's iconic shade of blue.

Jodhpur has historically been the capital of the kingdom known as Marwar, which is now part of Rajasthan. Jodhpur is a popular tourist destination, featuring many palaces, forts and temples, set in the stark landscape of the Thar Desert. The old city circles the fort and is bounded by a wall with several gates.
