End of October is peak tourist season hence you are requested to confirm your participation at the earliest so that accommodation arrangements can be made.



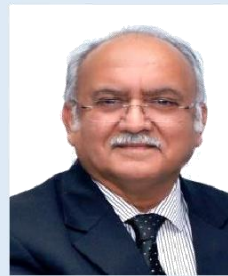
