

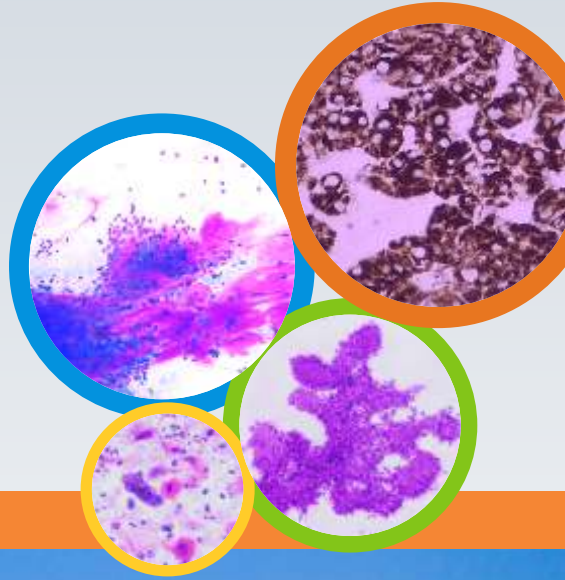


CME on Update in Cytopathology with special emphasis on Liquid Based Cytology.
