- Dimensions: 1189mm (H) x 841mm (W) or 46.8inches (H) x 33.1inches (W)
- Each poster will be displayed for 3hrs as per the session allocated for the poster
- Poster should be mounted before 10 am
- Time allocated is 7 minutes for presentation +2 minutes for questions
- Main author is requested to be present at their poster during poster viewing session. If you are unavailable to present, you need to submit the letter of authorisation to the person representing.
- Please fix your poster on the panel marked with your poster number. Fixing material will be provided in the poster area
- Posters should be removed by 4.30 pm
- Judges decision will be final
